House Bill 2756

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits public education program from purchasing, building or otherwise taking possession of seclusion cell or from using seclusion cells.

Directs public education program to remove seclusion cells from classrooms by specified date and to remove seclusion cells from premises of public education program by specified date. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

17	(2) No later than July 1, 2013, a public education program shall ensure that all seclusion
18	cells are removed from the classrooms of the public education program.
19	(3) No later than September 1, 2013, a public education program shall ensure that all se-
20	clusion cells are removed from the premises of the public education program.
21	SECTION 5. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
22	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect
23	on its passage.

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
