

CONFERENCE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2898

July 5

Amended Summary

Allows student with disability to earn credit at community college or public university as part of transition services.

Prohibits denying financial aid to student for sole reason that student did not receive regular high school diploma.

[Directs district boundary board to order boundary change if specified conditions met.]

Allows **Portland** Community College to establish public safety training facility in area zoned for exclusive farm use **in Columbia County**.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

Speaker Kotek:

Your Conference Committee to whom was referred A-engrossed House Bill 2898, having had the same under consideration, respectfully reports it back with the recommendation that the House concur in the Senate amendments dated June 3 and that the bill be amended as follows and repassed.

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, delete “330.092 and”.

2 On page 4, delete lines 30 through 45 and delete page 5 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 3. (1) As used in this section, ‘public safety training facility’ or ‘facility’ means**
4 **one or more improvements established by Portland Community College in support of curric-**
5 **ulum focused on public safety training or education, including public safety response to an**
6 **emergency, as defined in ORS 401.025.**

7 **“(2) In addition to the nonfarm uses that may be established in an area zoned for exclu-**
8 **sive farm use under ORS 215.283 (1), Portland Community College may establish a public**
9 **safety training facility as an outright permitted use on up to 300 acres of land in an area**
10 **zoned for exclusive farm use, notwithstanding:**

11 **“(a) The statewide land use planning goals and administrative rules adopted by the Land**
12 **Conservation and Development Commission.**

13 **“(b) The minimum lot or parcel size under ORS 215.780.**

14 **“(3) Portland Community College may establish the public safety training facility jointly**
15 **in cooperation with one or more other public bodies, as defined in ORS 174.109.**

16 **“(4) Portland Community College shall:**

17 **“(a) Use the public safety training facility to support curriculum focused on public safety**
18 **training and education; and**

19 **“(b) Make the facility available for use by other public bodies for public safety training**
20 **or education of public safety personnel, as defined in ORS 181.610, and other providers of**
21 **emergency services, as defined in ORS 401.025.**

22 **“(5) A public safety training facility authorized by this section:**

23 **“(a) Must be sited on land that is within a community college district in Columbia**
24 **County.**
