## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2898

1	On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete "343.035" and insert "330.092 and 343.035; and de-
<b>2</b>	claring an emergency".
3	On page 4, after line 23, insert:
4	" <u>SECTION 3.</u> Section 4 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 330.
5	" <u>SECTION 4.</u> (1) Upon receipt of a petition meeting the requirements of subsections (2)
6	to (4) of this section, the district boundary board shall order a boundary change.
7	"(2) A petition for a proposed change allowed under this section may be submitted only
8	by a city that:
9	"(a) Is amending its comprehensive plan and land use regulations to plan and zone land
10	annexed to the city as the result of an urban growth boundary expansion that occurred
11	within three years before the date of the submission of the petition; and
12	"(b) Has made findings that a change in the boundary of the school district would:
13	"(A) Decrease total transportation costs for the affected school districts; and
14	"(B) Result in greater efficiencies in the delivery of educational services.
15	"(3) A petition submitted under this section shall:
16	"(a) Be directed to the district boundary board of the county or counties having juris-
17	diction over the affected school districts;
18	"(b) Contain the names and numbers of the school districts affected by the change;
19	"(c) Contain a concise statement of the type of change requested and a legal description
20	of the portion of the school district that will be the subject of the change; and
21	"(d) Contain a proposal for the distribution of the assets and liabilities of the area af-
22	fected by the proposed change.
23	"(4) A petition may be submitted under this section only if one district boundary board
24	must issue an order related to the change.
25	"(5) Before a petition for a proposed change is considered, the district boundary board
26	shall give notice in the same manner provided by ORS 330.400 of the proposed change and the
27	session of the board at which it will be considered. If the district boundary board determines
28	that the petition meets the requirements of subsections (2) to (4) of this section, the board
29	shall issue an order that the change shall become effective as provided in ORS 330.103. The
30	board may not allow a remonstrance petition or election.
31	"(6) If a boundary change made under this section causes a school to be located in a
32	different school district, the employees of the school may elect to transfer to the different
33	school district. If an employee elects a transfer as provided by this subsection, the employee
34	may not be deprived of seniority or accumulated sick leave solely because the duties of the
35	employee have been assumed or acquired by the different school district.

1 "SECTION 5. ORS 330.092 is amended to read:

2 "330.092. The boundaries of a school district may not be changed except:

3 "(1) Pursuant to ORS 330.090 (1) or (3) or section 4 of this 2013 Act.

4 "(2) By a vote of the people pursuant to the lengthening of the course of study under ORS 5 chapter 335.

6 "(3) By the mutual consent of the district school boards of the two or more affected districts in 7 the manner prescribed in ORS 330.080 to 330.107.

8 "(4) On a request for change or merger proposal submitted to the district boundary board by 9 electors of the affected districts in the manner prescribed in ORS 330.080 to 330.107.

10 "<u>SECTION 6.</u> (1) As used in this section, 'public safety training facility' or 'facility' means 11 one or more improvements established by a community college in support of curriculum fo-12 cused on public safety training or education, including public safety response to an emer-13 gency, as defined in ORS 401.025.

"(2) In addition to the nonfarm uses that may be established in an area zoned for exclusive farm use under ORS 215.213 (1) or 215.283 (1), a community college may establish a public safety training facility as an outright permitted use in an area zoned for exclusive farm use. "(3) The community college may establish the facility jointly in cooperation with one or more other public bodies, as defined in ORS 174.109.

19 "(4) The community college shall:

"(a) Use the facility to support curriculum focused on public safety training and educa tion; and

"(b) Make the facility available for use by other public bodies for public safety training
or education of public safety personnel, as defined in ORS 181.610, and other providers of
emergency services, as defined in ORS 401.025.

"(5) Only one public safety training facility may be established under this section in each
 county.

27 "<u>SECTION 7.</u> This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
28 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect
29 on its passage.".

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
