## House Bill 2902

Sponsored by Representatives KOTEK, THOMPSON, Senators MONNES ANDERSON, KRUSE; Representatives CLEM, GREENLICK, HICKS, KENNEMER, LIVELY, PARRISH, TOMEI, Senators BATES, KNOPP, SHIELDS

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires insurers to reimburse physician assistants and nurse practitioners at same rate as physicians for same services.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to equal pay for health practitioners; creating new provisions; amending ORS 743A.036; and

3 declaring an emergency.

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4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 743A.036 is amended to read:

6 743A.036. (1) Whenever any policy of health insurance provides for reimbursement for [any ser-7 vice which is within the lawful scope of practice of a duly licensed and certified nurse practitioner, 8 including prescribing or dispensing drugs] a primary care or mental health service provided by 9 a licensed physician, the insured under the policy is entitled to reimbursement for such service 10 [whether it is performed by a physician licensed by the Oregon Medical Board or by a duly licensed 11 nurse practitioner] if provided by a licensed physician assistant or a certified nurse practitioner 12if the service is within the lawful scope of practice of the physician assistant or nurse practitioner. 13

(2) The reimbursement of a service provided by a licensed physician assistant or certified nurse practitioner under subsection (1) of this section shall be in the same amount as the reimbursement paid under the policy to a licensed physician performing the service in the area served.

[(2)] (3) This section does not apply to group practice health maintenance organizations that are
federally qualified pursuant to Title XIII of the Health Maintenance Organization Act.

20 SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 743A.036 by section 1 of this 2013 Act apply:

21 (1) To services provided under contracts entered into or renewed on or after the effective

date of this 2013 Act by in-network, as defined in ORS 743.871, physician assistants or nurse practitioners.

(2) To services provided on or after the effective date of this 2013 Act by out-of-network,
as defined in ORS 743.871, physician assistants or nurse practitioners.

26 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 27 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect 28 on its passage.
