2	"SECTION 1. (1) The Governor shall submit a written report to the 2014 regular session
3	of the Legislative Assembly on best practices for the use of boards, commissions, task forces
4	and work groups as tools for better government and as resources for engaging and con-
5	ducting public outreach with Oregonians.
6	"(2) The report may include:
7	"(a) Criteria or conditions that must be met prior to the establishment of a board, com-
8	mission, task force or work group;
9	"(b) Criteria or rules of procedure that must be included in the statute or other organ-
10	izational document establishing or modifying the duties of the board, commission, task force
11	or work group;
12	"(c) Information on costs routinely incurred in administering a board or commission;
13	"(d) Recommended training for members of a board, commission, task force or work
14	group;
15	"(e) Recommended processes for receiving, investigating and bringing to resolution
16	complaints about boards, commissions, task forces and work groups; and
17	"(f) Any other information the Governor determines is warranted for inclusion in the
18	report.
19	"(3) The report shall include:
20	"(a) Recommendations on how to identify and reduce fragmentation, duplication and re-
21	dundancy among existing boards and commissions;
22	"(b) A review of currently existing boards, commissions, task forces and work groups
23	that identifies opportunities to conclude work, combine missions or consolidate agencies; and
24	"(c) Recommendations on procedures for establishing a periodic and ongoing review of
25	boards, commissions, task forces and work groups to ensure retention of those entities for
26	which a demonstrated need continues to exist.
27	"(4) In preparing the report described in subsection (1) of this section, the Governor shall
28	consult with the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the
29	co-chairs of the Ways and Means Subcommittee on General Government and the Secretary
30	of State, or their designees.
31	"(5) After making the report described in subsection (1) of this section, the Governor
32	may make supplemental findings and recommendations to the Legislative Assembly at any
33	time, concerning the use of boards, commissions, task forces and work groups.
34	"SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2013 Act is repealed on January 2, 2017.".
