## **A-Engrossed** House Bill 3098

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Authorizes owners of Young Life - Washington Family Ranch to develop approximately 4,000-acre expansion area. Exempts development from statewide land use planning goals and provisions of ac-knowledged comprehensive plans and land use regulations of Jefferson County and Wasco County.] Authorizes establishment of youth camp on certain lands zoned for exclusive farm use in eastern Oregon. Requires Land Conservation and Development Commission to adopt rules

necessary for implementation of Act.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

2	Relating to youth camp expansion; creating new provisions; amending ORS 215.457; and declaring

4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. ORS 215.457 is amended to read:
6	215.457. A person may establish a youth camp:
7	(1) On land zoned for forest use or mixed farm and forest use, consistent with rules adopted by
8	the Land Conservation and Development Commission [under section 3, chapter 586, Oregon Laws
	1999].

10	(2) On land in eastern Oregon, as defined in ORS 321.805, that is zoned for exclusive farm
11	use and is composed predominantly of class VI, VII or VIII soils, consistent with rules
12	adopted by the Land Conservation and Development Commission.
13	SECTION 2. (1) Within one year after the effective date of this 2013 Act, the Land Con-
14	servation and Development Commission shall adopt rules to establish criteria for implemen-
15	tation of ORS 215.457 (2).
16	(2) The rules must:
17	(a) Protect adjacent uses in a manner that is substantially similar to the protections
18	described in ORS 215.296; and
19	(b) Be based on the rules adopted under ORS 215.457 before the effective date of this 2013
20	Act.
21	(3) A local government may not authorize the establishment of a youth camp under ORS
22	215.457 (2) before the effective date of rules adopted under this section.
23	SECTION 3. The amendments to ORS 215.457 by section 1 of this 2013 Act become oper-
24	ative on the effective date of rules adopted under section 2 of this 2013 Act. The Land Con-
25	servation and Development Commission shall notify the Legislative Counsel immediately

- 1 upon filing the rules with the Secretary of State.
- 2 <u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
- peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect
  on its passage.

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
