## House Bill 3175

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs public universities and community colleges to increase voter registration access and information.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 2 Relating to voter registration. 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "school of higher education" means: 4 (a) Any public university listed in ORS 352.002. 5 6 (b) Any community college as defined in ORS 341.005. 7 (2) Each school of higher education shall prominently display a direct link to the Secretary of State's online voter registration tool on the school's home page and on each page of 8 the school's website that relates to: 9 (a) Class registration; 10 (b) Financial aid filing; and 11 12 (c) Any online course management system that educators use to coordinate class mate-13rials and assignments with students. (3) In addition to the requirements of subsection (2) of this section, each school of higher 14 education shall prominently display a direct link to the Secretary of State's online voter 15registration tool on the 10 pages on the school's website that have the highest traffic, as 16 17 determined by the school at the end of each academic year. (4) Each school of higher education shall give the school's official student government 18 19 permission and opportunity to provide voter registration services: (a) During student orientation programs held by the school's administration; 20 21(b) During campus welcome events that occur before classes begin each academic term; 22(c) During the first week of classes in each academic term; (d) In the form of a presentation that lasts at least 10 minutes and is given in the 23 24 classroom of every course offered during an academic term; and 25(e) Throughout the academic term in any nonreserved public space on the school's 26 property. 27(5) During every academic term, a school of higher education shall send at least two re-28 minders to each of its students to register to vote. The reminders shall be sent by electronic mail and shall contain a direct link to the Secretary of State's online voter registration tool. 29When an election as defined in ORS 246.012 will occur during an academic term, the school 30 shall send a reminder to each of its students on the morning of the voter registration dead-31 NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
