## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3199

Delete lines 4 through 25 of the printed bill and insert: 1 2 "SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 477. "SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section: 3 "(a) 'Exploding target' means a device: 4 5 "(A) Designed for use or used as a target for small arms ammunition or for other projectiles; 6 "(B) Consisting of a flammable substance or flammable combination of substances; and 7 "(C) Capable of exploding when struck by small arms gunfire or by other projectiles. 8 9 "(b) 'Sky lantern' means an unmanned self-contained luminary device that uses heated 10 air produced by an open flame or produced by another source to become or remain airborne. 11 "(c) 'Small arms' means a shotgun, rifle, pistol or revolver. "(d) 'Tracer ammunition' means a bullet that contains a flammable substance designed 1213 to ignite upon firing of the bullet and to burn with sufficient brightness to allow observation 14 of the bullet trajectory. 15"(2) A person violates this section if, during a fire season declared under ORS 477.505 for 16 a forest protection district or a part of a forest protection district: 17 "(a) The person releases a sky lantern or discharges an exploding target or tracer am-18 munition on land that is inside the district or is within one-eighth of a mile of the district; 19 or 20 "(b) A sky lantern released by the person or tracer ammunition discharged by the person 21crosses above land that is inside the district or is within one-eighth of a mile of the district. "(3) Violation of this section is a Class A violation. In addition to any enforcement officer 22specifically identified in ORS 153.005, the State Fire Marshal, the State Forestry Department 2324 or the State Forester may issue a citation for a violation under this section.". 25
