House Bill 3278

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Permits appellate court to vacate juvenile court judgment or order and remand to juvenile court for reconsideration.

Establishes right to appeal from modified or original judgment or order after reconsideration by juvenile court.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to appeals in juvenile court proceedings.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 419A.

5 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) Upon joint motion of the parties to an appeal from a judgment or order

6 of the juvenile court, the court may vacate the judgment or order from which the appeal

7 was taken and remand the matter to the juvenile court to reconsider the judgment or order,

8 or any order entered by the juvenile court. Upon remand, the juvenile court shall have ju-

9 risdiction to enter a modified judgment or order.

10 (2) After entry of a modified judgment or order on reconsideration, or upon reentry of 11 the original judgment or order, either party may appeal in the same time and manner as an

12 appeal from the original judgment or order.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> Section 2 of this 2013 Act applies to appeals from judgments and orders of
juvenile courts entered on or after the effective date of this 2013 Act.
