HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3460

2	Delete lines 7 through 28 and delete page 2.
3	On <u>page 3</u> , delete lines 1 through 13 and insert:
4	" <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall establish by rule a medical marijuana
5	facility registration system to authorize the transfer of usable marijuana and immature
6	marijuana plants from:
7	"(a) A registry identification cardholder, the designated primary caregiver of a registry
8	identification cardholder, or a person responsible for a marijuana grow site to the medical
9	marijuana facility; or
10	"(b) A medical marijuana facility to a registry identification cardholder or the designated
11	primary caregiver of a registry identification cardholder.
12	"(2) The registration system established under subsection (1) of this section must require
13	a medical marijuana facility to submit an application to the authority that includes:
14	"(a) The name of the person responsible for the medical marijuana facility;
15	"(b) The address of the medical marijuana facility;
16	"(c) Proof that the person responsible for the medical marijuana facility is a resident of
17	Oregon;
18	"(d) Documentation, as required by the authority by rule, that demonstrates the medical
19	marijuana facility meets the qualifications for a medical marijuana facility as described in
20	subsection (3) of this section; and
21	"(e) Any other information that the authority considers necessary.
22	"(3) To qualify for registration under this section, a medical marijuana facility:
23	"(a) Must be located in an area that is zoned for commercial, industrial or mixed use or
24	as agricultural land and may not be located at the same address as a marijuana grow site;
25	"(b) Must be registered as a business or have filed a pending application to register as a
26	business with the Office of the Secretary of State;
27	"(c) Must not be located within 1,000 feet of the real property comprising a public or
28	private elementary, secondary or career school attended primarily by minors;
29	"(d) Must not be located within 1,000 feet of another medical marijuana facility; and
30	"(e) Must comport with rules adopted by the authority related to:
31	"(A) Installing a minimum security system, including a video surveillance system, alarm
32	system and safe; and
33	"(B) Testing for pesticides, mold and mildew and the processes by which usable
34	marijuana and immature marijuana plants that test positive for pesticides, mold or mildew
35	must be returned to the registry identification cardholder, the cardholder's designated pri-

1 mary caregiver or the cardholder's registered grower.

2 "(4)(a) The authority shall conduct a criminal records check under ORS 181.534 of a person whose name is submitted as the person responsible for a medical marijuana facility 3 4 under subsection (2) of this section.

"(b) A person convicted of a Class A or Class B felony under ORS 475.752 to 475.920 for 5 the manufacture or delivery of a controlled substance in Schedule I or Schedule II may not 6 7 be the person responsible for a medical marijuana facility for five years from the date the 8 person is convicted.

(c) A person convicted more than once of a Class A or Class B felony under ORS 475.752 9 to 475.920 for the manufacture or delivery of a controlled substance in Schedule I or Schedule 10 11 II may not be the person responsible for a medical marijuana facility.

(5) If a person submits the application required under subsection (2) of this section, the 1213medical marijuana facility identified in the application meets the qualifications for a medical marijuana facility described in subsection (3) of this section and the person responsible for 14 15the medical marijuana facility passes the criminal records check required under subsection 16 (4) of this section, the authority shall register the medical marijuana facility and issue the person responsible for the medical marijuana facility proof of registration. The person re-1718 sponsible for the medical marijuana facility shall display the proof of registration on the 19 premises of the medical marijuana facility at all times when usable marijuana or immature 20marijuana plants are being transferred as described in subsection (1) of this section.

21(6)(a) A registered medical marijuana facility may receive usable marijuana or immature 22marijuana plants only from a registry identification cardholder, designated primary caregiver 23or person responsible for a marijuana grow site if the registered medical marijuana facility obtains authorization, on a form prescribed by the authority by rule and signed by a registry 24 25identification cardholder, to receive the usable marijuana or immature marijuana plants.

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"(b) A registered medical marijuana facility shall maintain:

"(A) A copy of each authorization form described in paragraph (a) of this subsection; and

"(B) Documentation of each transfer of usable marijuana or immature marijuana plants. 28 29 "(7) A medical marijuana facility registered under this section may possess usable 30 marijuana and immature marijuana plants in excess of the limits imposed on registry identification cardholders and designated primary caregivers under ORS 475.320. 31

"(8) The authority may inspect:

33 (a) The premises of an applicant for a medical marijuana facility or a registered medical 34marijuana facility to ensure compliance with the qualifications for a medical marijuana fa-35 cility described in subsection (3) of this section; and

"(b) The records of a registered medical marijuana facility to ensure compliance with 36 37 subsection (6)(b) of this section.

"(9)(a) A registry identification cardholder or the designated primary caregiver of a reg-38 39 istry identification cardholder may reimburse a medical marijuana facility registered under 40 this section for the normal and customary costs of doing business, including costs related 41 to transferring, handling, securing, insuring, testing, packaging and processing usable marijuana and immature marijuana plants and the cost of supplies, utilities and rent or 42mortgage. 43

44 (b) A medical marijuana facility may reimburse a person responsible for a marijuana 45 grow site under this section for the normal and customary costs of doing business, including

1 costs related to transferring, handling, securing, insuring, testing, packaging and processing 2 usable marijuana and immature marijuana plants and the cost of supplies, utilities and rent or mortgage. 3 4 "(10) The authority may revoke the registration of a medical marijuana facility registered under this section for failure to comply with ORS 475.300 to 475.346 or rules adopted under 5 ORS 475.300 to 475.346. The authority may release to the public a final order revoking a 6 7 medical marijuana facility registration. ery or production of marijuana or any other criminal offense in which possession, delivery or pro-

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1 duction of marijuana is an element as described in ORS 475.309 (1) until the operative date specified

2 in subsection (1) of this section.

3 "SECTION 10. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$803,276 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for 4 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, $\mathbf{5}$ but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Health 6 Authority for administrative and operating expenses incurred in implementing section 2 of 7 this 2013 Act and the amendments to ORS 475.302, 475.304, 475.309, 475.320, 475.323 and 475.331 8 by sections 3 to 8 of this 2013 Act.". 9 In line 31, delete "10" and insert "11". 10

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
