SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs distribution of moneys from Criminal Fine Account. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2013.

A BILL FOR AN ACT Relating to the financial administration of the Criminal Fine Account; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding ORS 137.300, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, the 4 Department of Revenue shall distribute the moneys in the Criminal Fine Account established $\mathbf{5}$ by ORS 137.300 as specified in sections 2 to 7 of this 2013 Act. 6 7 SECTION 2. There is allocated to the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, from the Criminal Fine Account the amount of 8 \$22,718,363 for the purpose of criminal justice training and standards operations. 9 SECTION 3. The 2122grant to each county shall be based on amounts deposited in the Criminal Fine and Assess-23ment Account by the circuit court for the county in the 2009-2011 biennium. (5) There is allocated to the Arrest and Return Account established under ORS 133.865 24for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, from the Criminal Fine Account the amount of 25\$22,500. 2627(6) There is allocated to the Intoxicated Driver Program Fund created under ORS 813.270 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, from the Criminal Fine Account the amount of 28\$4,323,000. 2930 SECTION 8. After distributing the amounts specified in sections 2 to 7 of this 2013 Act, 31 the Department of Revenue shall distribute funds remaining in the Criminal Fine Account to the General Fund. 32SECTION 9. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 33 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect 34
