House Joint Memorial 2

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Urges United States Secretary of Interior to allow enhanced management of cormorants by State of Oregon.

1	JOINT MEMORIAL
2	To the United States Secretary of the Interior:
3	We, your memorialists, the Seventy-seventh Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon, in
4	legislative session assembled, respectfully represent as follows:
5	Whereas the population of cormorants has increased in Oregon in recent years; and
6	Whereas cormorants have hindered efforts to protect the salmon and steelhead resources of
7	Oregon; and
8	Whereas current efforts to control the negative effects of cormorants on the salmon and
9	steelhead resources of Oregon have been ineffective; and
10	Whereas other options are necessary to protect the salmon and steelhead resources of Oregon;
11	now, therefore,
12	Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:
13	(1) The United States Secretary of the Interior is respectfully urged to allow the enhanced
14	management of cormorants in Oregon by the State of Oregon in order to reduce depredations of the
15	salmon and steelhead resources of Oregon by cormorants.
16	(2) A copy of this memorial shall be sent to the United States Secretary of the Interior.
