77th OREGON LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY--2013 Regular Session

Senate Bill 580

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON RURAL COMMUNITIES AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Prescribes duties for specified scientific and technical advisory committee and gives committee authority to select members.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to ocean resources; amending ORS 196.451; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3

SECTION 1. ORS 196.451 is amended to read: 4

196.451. (1) [To aid and advise the Ocean Policy Advisory Council in the performance of its func-5

tions, the council] The Ocean Policy Advisory Council shall establish a permanent scientific and technical advisory committee chaired by the director of the Sea Grant College program or other 7

8 similarly qualified member of the [Ocean Policy Advisory Council and may establish additional com-

mittees as needed] council. 9

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(2) The committee shall consist of members: 10

(a) Appointed by the council; or 11

12 (b) Selected according to the procedures described in subsection (4) of this section.

(3) The committee shall: 13

14 (a) Aid and advise the council in the performance of the council's functions.

(b) Advise, subject to the availability of funds and time, state agencies on matters related 15

16 to this state's ocean or nearshore resources.

17(4) If the committee determines that it is not equipped to perform its research duties, the committee may select individuals for committee membership according to the following 18 19 procedures:

20 (a) The committee first must determine that a new discipline needs to be represented by 21the committee.

22(b) After determining that a new discipline needs to be represented, the committee must 23solicit the names of candidates from the public.

(c) The committee must evaluate the expertise of the candidates, nominate candidates 24for committee membership and solicit feedback from the public on those nominations. In 25 evaluating and nominating candidates under this paragraph, the committee must consider 26 the candidate's expertise and availability and any potential or actual conflict of interest. 27

(d) After receiving feedback from the public, the committee may select a new member 28 from among the candidates. 29

(5) In accordance with ORS chapter 183, the council shall adopt rules for the adminis-30 tration of subsection (4) of this section. 31

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[(2)] (6) The council may establish additional advisory committees as needed. Members of any advisory committee established under this section [Members of the advisory committees] are not entitled to compensation, but in the discretion of the council may be reimbursed from funds available to council for actual and necessary travel and other expenses incurred by them in the performance of their official duties, subject to ORS 292.495.

6 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 7 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect 8 on its passage.

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
