## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2207

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the semicolon insert "creating 2 new provisions; and".

3 Delete lines 25 through 27 and insert:

4 "(b) The department shall electronically provide itemized statements of 5 payroll deductions to the recipient.

6 "(c) If the department determines that electronic payment of net salary 7 and wages is not practicable or efficient, payment may be made by paper 8 check or by a credit to a bank-issued payroll card.

9 "(d) Notwithstanding paragraph (b) of this subsection, if an officer or 10 employee wants to receive payment of net salary and wages by check or to 11 receive a paper statement of itemized payroll deductions, the officer or em-12 ployee shall request paper statements or payment by check in accordance 13 with the procedures adopted by rule by the department.".

14 On page 2, line 6, delete "Unpresented".

In line 7, delete the boldfaced material and insert "Payments not transferred to the person entitled to receive the payment".

17 On page 3, line 29, after "provided" insert "electronically".

In line 30, delete "to" and insert a period.

19 Delete line 31 and insert:

"(d) State agencies shall provide access to electronic statements to em ployees that do not have regular access to computers in their workplace.

22 "(e) Notwithstanding paragraph (c) of this subsection, if an officer or

employee paid under the state payroll system as provided by ORS 292.026 wants to receive payment of net salary and wages by check or to receive a paper statement of itemized payroll deductions, the officer or employee shall request paper statements or payment by check in accordance with the procedures adopted by rule by the department.".

6 On page 4, after line 21, insert:

"<u>SECTION 6.</u> The amendments to ORS 292.026, 292.032, 292.033,
652.110 and 652.610 by sections 1 to 5 of this 2013 Act become operative
on January 1, 2014.

"<u>SECTION 7.</u> The Director of the Oregon Department of Administrative Services may take any action before the operative date specified in section 6 of this 2013 Act that is necessary to enable the department to exercise, on and after the operative date specified in section 6 of this 2013 Act, all the duties, functions and powers conferred on the department by this 2013 Act.".
