PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2203

1 On <u>page 1</u> of the printed bill, line 2, delete "; amending ORS 758.010".

2 Delete lines 4 through 31 and delete <u>page 2</u> and insert:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Sections 2 and 3 of this 2013 Act are added to and
made a part of ORS chapter 758.

5 "SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section:

6 "(a) 'Public utility' has the meaning given that term in ORS 757.005.

"(b) "Transmission line' means a linear utility facility by which a
utility provider transmits or transfers electricity from a point of origin
or generation or between transfer stations.

"(2) A person who applies for a permit with the Energy Facility 10 Siting Council or with a county to build a transmission line must no-11 tify each people's utility district organized under ORS chapter 261, 12municipal utility organized under ORS chapter 225, electric cooperative 13 organized under ORS chapter 62 and public utility in whose service 14 territory the transmission line will be constructed of the intent to re-15ceive approval for the construction of the transmission line unless the 16 person is: 17

"(a) A people's utility district organized under ORS chapter 261, a
 municipal utility organized under ORS chapter 225 or an electric co operative organized under ORS chapter 62; or

21 **"(b) A public utility.**

²² "<u>SECTION 3.</u> (1) Each person who is subject to the Public Utility

Commission's authority under ORS 757.035 and who engages in the operation of an electric power line as described in ORS 757.035 must provide the commission with the following information before January 2 of each even-numbered year:

"(a) The name and contact information of the person that is responsible for the operation and maintenance of the electric power line,
and for ensuring that the electric power line is safe, on an ongoing
basis; and

9 "(b) The name and contact information of the person who is re-10 sponsible for responding to conditions that present an imminent threat 11 to the safety of employees, customers and the public.

"(2) In the event that the contact information described in subsection (1) of this section changes or that ownership of the electric power line changes, the person who engages in the operation of the electric power line must notify the commission of the change as soon as practicable, but no later than within 90 days.

"(3) If the person described in subsection (1) of this section is not the public utility, as defined in ORS 757.005, in whose service territory the electric power line is located, the commission shall make the information provided to the commission under subsection (1) of this section available to the public utility in whose service territory the electric power line is located.

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
