## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3254

1 On <u>page 1</u> of the printed bill, line 2, before "amending" insert "and".

2 In line 3, delete "; and declaring an emergency".

3 On <u>page 2</u>, line 31, delete "shall qualify" and insert "is an optional license 4 that qualifies".

5 In line 32, before the period insert "and signifies that the holder adheres 6 to the same standards established for educational assistants".

7 Delete lines 42 through 44 and insert:

8 "(2) A teacher leader license shall be issued on application to an other9 wise qualified person who:

10 "(a) Has a valid professional teaching license; and

"(b) Has been deemed to be effective to highly effective in teaching, as shown by evaluations conducted in compliance with ORS 342.856 or as shown by other evidence identified by the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission by rule.".

15 On page 3, after line 1, insert:

"(4) The commission shall develop a process by which a teacher holding a teacher leader license is automatically issued a professional teaching license upon nonrenewal of a teacher leader license if the teacher meets the requirements for a professional teaching license.".

In line 12, after "renewed" delete the rest of the line and insert "every three years up to three times.

an initial teaching license to renew the initial teaching license after the time
limit imposed by subsection (3) of this section if the teacher does not qualify
for a professional teaching license due to lack of employment.".

In line 38, delete "four" and insert "three and one-half" and after teacher" insert ", including mentoring, curriculum development support, teacher preparation support and other educational leadership".

7 On page 5, delete lines 16 through 18 and insert:

8 "SECTION 11. The Teacher Standards and Practices Commission 9 shall ensure that instructor licenses and teacher leader licenses may 10 be first issued no later than July 1, 2014.".

11
