## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 217

1 On <u>page 1</u> of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 29 and delete <u>page</u> 2 <u>2</u> and insert:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part
of ORS chapter 536.

5 "SECTION 2. (1) Subject to subsection (2) of this section, an annual 6 management fee of \$100 is imposed on each primary and each supple-7 mental water right held for waters of this state under a water right 8 permit, water right certificate, decree or groundwater registration. 9 Each water right is subject to a single management fee regardless of 10 the number of documents setting forth the water right.

"(2) If a water right holder is other than a municipality or provider 11 of water for municipal purposes, the total amount of water right 12management fees that may be imposed on the water right holder under 13 this section may not exceed \$1,000 annually regardless of the number 14 of water rights held. If a water right holder is a municipality or pro-15vider of water for municipal purposes, the total amount of water right 16 management fees that may be imposed on the water right holder under 17 this section may not exceed \$2,500 annually regardless of the number 18 of water rights held. 19

20 "(3) The Water Resources Commission shall adopt rules providing 21 for the Water Resources Department to assess and collect the water 22 right management fee imposed under this section. Moneys collected under this section shall be deposited into the Water Resources De partment Water Right Operating Fund.

"(4) If a water right management fee imposed under this section is not paid when due, after providing the water right holder with notice and opportunity for hearing under ORS chapter 183, the department may issue an order for payment of the delinquent amount and forward the order for enforcement through collection. The department may not regulate or limit water use due to nonpayment of a water right management fee.

"536.009. (1) There is established in the State Treasury the Water Resources Department Water Right Operating Fund, separate and distinct from the General Fund.[, to provide for the payment of the program and administrative expenses of the Water Resources Commission and the Water Resources Department in carrying out the provisions of ORS chapters 536, 537, 540 and 541.] Interest earned by the Water Resources Department Water Right Operating Fund shall be credited to the fund.

18 "(2) The fund shall consist of:

"(a) All moneys received under ORS 536.050 and 537.747 and section 2
of this 2013 Act.

"(b) All moneys received on behalf of the fund by gift, grant or appro-priation from whatever source.

"(3) [All] Moneys in the fund are continuously appropriated to the Water 23Resources Department [for payment of expenses as described in this section.] 24to provide for the payment of the program and administrative ex-25penses of the Water Resources Commission and the department in 26carrying out the provisions of ORS chapters 536, 537, 540 and 541. 27However, moneys deposited into the fund from water right manage-28ment fees imposed under section 2 of this 2013 Act may be used only 29 to fund field, technical and administrative activities of the department 30

that are directly related to water rights management, including, but
not limited to, the administration, maintenance and protection of the
water right permit and certificate system.

"SECTION 4. (1) Section 2 of this 2013 Act first applies to the period beginning July 1, 2013. If this 2013 Act does not become effective until after July 1, 2013, the Legislative Assembly intends that section 2 of this 2013 Act and the amendments to ORS 536.009 by section 3 of this 2013 Act shall apply retroactively to allow assessment and collection of the water right management fee for the period beginning July 1, 2013.

"(2) No later than 90 days after the effective date of this 2013 Act,
 the Water Resources Commission shall adopt temporary rules to:

"(a) Enable the Water Resources Department to assess and collect
 the water right management fees owed for the period beginning July
 1, 2013; and

"(b) Guide the geographic distribution of department expenditures
 of water right management fees under ORS 536.009 (3).

"SECTION 5. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate
 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
 declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.".

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
