PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3098

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "expansion" insert "; creating
- 2 new provisions; amending ORS 215.457; and declaring an emergency".
- Delete lines 4 through 30 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:
- **"SECTION 1.** ORS 215.457 is amended to read:
- 5 "215.457. A person may establish a youth camp:
- 6 "(1) On land zoned for forest use or mixed farm and forest use, consistent
- 7 with rules adopted by the Land Conservation and Development Commission
- 8 [under section 3, chapter 586, Oregon Laws 1999].
- 9 "(2) On land in eastern Oregon, as defined in ORS 321.805, that is
- 20 zoned for exclusive farm use and is composed predominantly of class
- 11 VI, VII or VIII soils, consistent with rules adopted by the Land Con-
- 12 servation and Development Commission.
- "SECTION 2. (1) Within one year after the effective date of this 2013
- 14 Act, the Land Conservation and Development Commission shall adopt
- rules to establish criteria for implementation of ORS 215.457 (2).
- 16 "(2) The rules must:
- "(a) Protect adjacent uses in a manner that is substantially similar
- to the protections described in ORS 215.296; and
- 19 "(b) Be based on the rules adopted under ORS 215.457 before the
- 20 effective date of this 2013 Act.
- 21 "(3) A local government may not authorize the establishment of a
- 22 youth camp under ORS 215.457 (2) before the effective date of rules

adopted under section 2 of this 2013 Act.

"SECTION 3. The amendments to ORS 215.457 by section 1 of this 2013 Act become operative on the effective date of rules adopted under section 2 of this 2013 Act. The Land Conservation and Development Commission shall notify the Legislative Counsel immediately upon filing the rules with the Secretary of State.

"SECTION 4. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage."
