## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 511

In line 2 of the printed bill, after "lane" insert a period and delete the rest of the line and delete line 3.

3 Delete lines 5 through 27 and insert:

4 "SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part
5 of the Oregon Vehicle Code.

6 "SECTION 2. (1) A person commits the offense of failure to keep a 7 vehicle in the right lane if the person is operating a vehicle and the 8 person drives the vehicle in the far left lane on a roadway that has two 9 or more lanes for traffic proceeding in a single direction.

10 "(2) A person may drive in the far left lane:

"(a) When overtaking and passing another vehicle proceeding in the
same direction under the rules governing this movement in ORS
811.410 to 811.425 when such movement can be made without interfering with the passage of other vehicles.

15 "(b) When preparing to turn left.

"(c) When reasonably necessary in response to emergency condi tions.

"(d) To avoid actual or potential traffic moving onto the right lane
from an acceleration or merging lane.

"(e) When necessary to follow traffic control devices that direct use
of a lane other than the right lane or middle lane, if any.

<sup>22</sup> "(f) When the flow of traffic is moving at a slower speed than is

normal at the time and place and under the conditions then existing.
"(3) The offense described in this section, failure to keep a vehicle
in the right lane, is a Class B traffic violation.".
