## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 281

On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the semicolon insert "creating new provisions;" and before the period insert "; and declaring an emergency".

4 On page 2, after line 19, insert:

"SECTION 2. (1) There is created a work group to study the regulation of marijuana under ORS 475.300 to 475.346 and alternatives to
the regulation of marijuana under ORS 475.300 to 475.346. The work
group shall consist of seven members as follows:

9 "(a) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint five
 10 members to the work group as follows:

"(A) Two members who must be members of the House of Representatives who served or are serving on the House Committee on Judiciary during the odd-numbered year regular session of the Seventy-seventh Legislative Assembly;

"(B) One member who must be an advocate of the medical use of
 marijuana;

"(C) One member who must be an advocate of the nonmedical use
 of marijuana; and

"(D) One member who must have a background in science and have
 studied medical applications of marijuana.

"(b) The Governor shall appoint two members to the work group
 as follows:

"(A) One member who must be a chief of police or a sheriff; and
"(B) One member who must be a representative from the Department of Justice.

"(2) The work group shall study the regulation of marijuana under
ORS 475.300 to 475.346 and alternatives to the regulation of marijuana
under ORS 475.300 to 475.346.

"(3) A majority of the members of the work group constitutes a
quorum for the transaction of business.

9 "(4) Official action by the work group requires the approval of a 10 majority of the members of the work group.

"(5) The work group shall elect one of its members to serve as
 chairperson.

"(6) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority
 shall make an appointment to become immediately effective.

"(7) The work group shall meet at times and places specified by the
 call of the chairperson or of a majority of the members of the work
 group.

"(8) The work group may adopt rules necessary for the operation
of the work group.

"(9) The work group shall make a report, and may make recom mendations for legislation, to the appropriate interim committees of
 the Legislative Assembly no later than January 15, 2014.

"(10) The work group may accept donations of staff support, office
space and equipment to assist the work group in the performance of
its functions and may use the services of continuing legislative staff.

"(11) Notwithstanding ORS 171.072, members of the work group who are members of the Legislative Assembly are not entitled to mileage expenses or a per diem and serve as volunteers on the work group. Other members of the work group are not entitled to compensation or reimbursement for expenses and serve as volunteers on the work 1 **group.** 

"(12) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, are directed to assist the work group in the performance of its duties and, to the extent permitted by laws relating to confidentiality, to furnish such information and advice as the members of the work group consider necessary to perform their duties.

"SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2013 Act is repealed on the date of
the convening of the 2014 regular session of the Legislative Assembly
as specified in ORS 171.010.

"SECTION 4. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate
 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
 declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.".
