PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 3441

On <u>page 1</u> of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 4 through 22 and delete <u>pages 2 through 4</u> and insert:

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"OREGON HATCHERY RESEARCH CENTER BOARD

"SECTION 1. Establishment of Oregon Hatchery Research Center 6 Board. (1) There is established the Oregon Hatchery Research Center 7 Board within the State Department of Fish and Wildlife. The board 8 shall consist of 14 members, including 11 voting members appointed 9 by the State Fish and Wildlife Director under subsection (2) of this 10 section and three nonvoting members specified in subsection (3) of this 11 section. Members of the board must be residents of this state who are 12well informed on matters related to fish management policy and 13 demonstrate an interest in the propagation of fish in hatcheries. 14

"(2) The 11 voting members appointed by the director shall be rep resentative of each of the following interests:

"(a) One member shall represent the Oregon Salmon Commission
 established under ORS 576.062.

"(b) One member shall represent the Columbia River gillnet salmon
fishery established under ORS 508.775 to 508.796.

"(c) Two members shall represent wild fish advocacy organizations.
"(d) Two members shall represent statewide sport angling organ-

1 izations.

2 "(e) One member shall represent the agricultural industry.

3 "(f) One member shall represent coastal ports.

4 "(g) One member shall represent the forest products industry.

5 "(h) One member shall represent independent fisheries scientists 6 and have a background in fish management and the propagation of 7 fish in hatcheries.

8 "(i) One member shall represent Oregon Indian tribes, to be ap-9 pointed by the director after consultation with the Commission on 10 Indian Services.

"(3) In addition to the members appointed under subsection (2) of
 this section, the director shall:

13 "(a) Appoint the following two nonvoting members of the board:

"(A) One member to represent the Oregon Watershed Enhancement
 Board.

"(B) One member, who is a fisheries scientist and has a background
 in fish management and the propagation of fish in hatcheries, to rep resent Oregon State University.

19 "(b) Invite a representative of the federal government, who is a 20 fisheries scientist and has a background in fish management and the 21 propagation of fish in hatcheries, to serve as a nonvoting member of 22 the board.

"(4) The term of office of each member is four years, but a member serves at the pleasure of the director. Before the expiration of the term of a member, the director shall appoint a successor whose term begins on July 1 next following. A member is eligible for reappointment. If there is a vacancy for any cause, the director shall make an appointment to become immediately effective for the unexpired term. (5) A member of the board is not entitled to compensation under

30 ORS 292.495. At the discretion of the board, board members may be

reimbursed from funds available to the board for actual and necessary
travel and other expenses incurred by members of the board in the
performance of their official duties, subject to the limits described in
ORS 292.495.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> Initial terms of office. Notwithstanding the term of
office specified in section 1 of this 2013 Act, of the members first appointed to the Oregon Hatchery Research Center Board pursuant to
section 1 (2) of this 2013 Act:

9 "(1) Five shall serve for a term ending June 30, 2015.

10 "(2) Six shall serve for a term ending June 30, 2016.

"SECTION 3. Duties of Oregon Hatchery Research Center Board.
 The Oregon Hatchery Research Center Board shall:

"(1) Establish strategic directions and operation objectives for the
 Oregon Hatchery Research Center located on Fall Creek, near Alsea,
 consistent with ORS 496.275.

"(2) Develop, after consultation with the Director of the Oregon
 Hatchery Research Center, Oregon State University and the State De partment of Fish and Wildlife, the proposed operating budget for the
 center.

"(3) Propose research projects for the Oregon Hatchery Research
 Center.

"(4) Review, approve and prioritize all research proposals for the Oregon Hatchery Research Center before research takes place, to determine if the proposed research meets the strategic directions and operation objectives specified in subsection (1) of this section.

"(5) Issue requests for research proposals as needed to carry out the
 activities of the Oregon Hatchery Research Center specified in section
 5 of this 2013 Act.

"(6) On or before February 1 of each calendar year, report to the
 Legislative Assembly in the manner required by ORS 192.245, and to

the State Fish and Wildlife Director and the State Fish and Wildlife Commission, regarding the findings of research projects carried out by the Oregon Hatchery Research Center and any recommendations regarding current hatchery management practices based on the research projects.

6 "<u>SECTION 4.</u> Officers, quorum and meetings. (1) The Oregon 7 Hatchery Research Center Board shall select one of its members as 8 chairperson and another as vice chairperson, for such terms and with 9 duties and powers necessary for the performance of the functions of 10 such offices as the board determines.

"(2) A majority of the voting members of the board constitutes a
 quorum for the transaction of business.

"(3) The board shall meet at least once every three months at a
 place, day and hour determined by the board. The board may also meet
 at other times and places specified by the call of the chairperson or
 of a majority of the members of the board.

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"OREGON HATCHERY RESEARCH CENTER

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²⁰ "<u>SECTION 5.</u> (1) The hatchery research center located on Fall ²¹ Creek, near Alsea, is named the Oregon Hatchery Research Center.

"(2) Pursuant to the strategic directions and operation objectives
established by the Oregon Hatchery Research Center Board under
section 3 of this 2013 Act, the center shall carry out the following activities:

"(a) Conduct research on methods to minimize the genetic and ecological risk to naturally produced fish when hatchery produced fish
are released in the waters of this state, while also maximizing the
consumptive harvest of hatchery produced fish.

30 "(b) Conduct research to determine the genetic and ecological risk

to naturally produced fish when wild broodstock hatchery produced
fish are released into the waters of this state.

"(c) Conduct research to determine the effect of hatchery operations on naturally produced fish and the habitat of naturally
produced fish.

6 "(d) Conduct research to implement and enhance the Oregon Plan
7 as defined in ORS 541.890.

"(e) Provide educational and research opportunities for undergraduate students, graduate students and postgraduate students.

"(f) Provide educational opportunities for the public and for stu dents in grades 1 through 12.

"(3) As used in this section, 'waters of this state' has the meaning
 given that term in ORS 196.800.

¹⁴ "<u>SECTION 6. Director.</u> The chairperson of a department related to ¹⁵ fish and wildlife at Oregon State University, after consultation with ¹⁶ the State Fish and Wildlife Director and the Oregon Hatchery Re-¹⁷ search Center Board established under section 1 of this 2013 Act, shall ¹⁸ appoint a Director of the Oregon Hatchery Research Center.

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"MISCELLANEOUS

"SECTION 7. No later than January 1, 2014, and in order to carry 22out the activities of the Oregon Hatchery Research Center specified in 23section 5 of this 2013 Act, the State Department of Fish and Wildlife 24shall, after consultation with the Oregon Hatchery Research Center 25Board established under section 1 of this 2013 Act, renegotiate any 26agreement entered into between the State Board of Higher Education 27and the State Department of Fish and Wildlife related to the Oregon 28Hatchery Research Center. 29

"SECTION 8. The State Fish and Wildlife Director shall make the

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appointments, and extend the invitation, specified in section 1 of this
 2013 Act related to members of the Oregon Hatchery Research Center
 Board no later than January 1, 2014.

"SECTION 9. The unit and section captions used in this 2013 Act
are provided only for the convenience of the reader and do not become
part of the statutory law of this state or express any legislative intent
in the enactment of this 2013 Act.

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"EMERGENCY CLAUSE

"SECTION 10. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate
 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
 declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.".

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
