PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 259

1 Delete lines 5 through 23 of the printed bill and insert:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part
 of ORS chapter 657.

4 "<u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) The Director of the Employment Department may
5 enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the federal govern6 ment for the purposes of:

"(a) Offsetting against liquidated state debt moneys that the federal
government owes to the debtor; and

9 "(b) Sharing information as necessary to make offsets under para10 graph (a) of this subsection.

"(2) The director may request an offset against liquidated state debt
 under this section only if:

13 "(a) The debt is legally enforceable;

14 "(b) The debt is past due;

"(c) The debt was caused by the debtor's willfully making a false
 statement or misrepresentation, or willfully failing to report a mate rial fact, to obtain any benefits under this chapter;

"(d) The debtor's appeal period for contesting the debt and the ele ment of causation described in paragraph (c) of this subsection has
 expired; and

"(e) The director has provided at least 60 days' advance written notice to the debtor that the debt will be offset pursuant to this section and that the debtor has the right to request administrative review
under rules adopted by the director pursuant to subsection (5) of this
section.

"(3)(a) The director may pay a fee charged by the federal government for processing a request for an offset under subsection (1) of this
section.

"(b) The net amount received from the federal government after
deduction of fees charged under paragraph (a) of this subsection shall
be offset against the debt.

"(4)(a) The director may pay a fee charged by the Department of
 Revenue pursuant to ORS 293.250 for processing a request to offset
 against liquidated state debt a state tax refund owed to the debtor.

"(b) The net amount received from the Department of Revenue af ter deduction of fees charged under paragraph (a) of this subsection
 shall be offset against the debt.

16 "(5) The director shall adopt rules consistent with federal require-17 ments for debt offsets requested under this section that establish the 18 requirements for the advance written notice provided to debtors, and 19 the procedures pursuant to which a debtor may obtain administrative 20 review, under this section.

21 "SECTION 3. The 60 days' advance written notice required under 22 section 2 (2)(e) of this 2013 Act is not valid unless it is sent on or after 23 the effective date of this 2013 Act, and the Director of the Employment 24 Department may not request an offset under section 2 (2) of this 2013 25 Act before the date that is 60 days after the effective date of this 2013 26 Act.

"<u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.".

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
