³ "SECTION 1. ORS 279C.555 is amended to read:

"279C.555. The withholding of retainage by a contractor or subcontractor
on public improvement contracts shall be in accordance with ORS 701.420
[and 701.430 except when the charter of the contracting agency contains provisions requiring retainage by the contracting agency of more than five percent
of the contract price of the work completed].

9 **"SECTION 2.** ORS 701.420 is amended to read:

¹⁰ "701.420. (1) Partial payment is allowed and may be made on contracts for ¹¹ construction and home improvement. [*Except as provided in ORS 701.430* ¹² (2),] An owner, contractor or subcontractor may withhold as retainage an ¹³ amount equal to not more than five percent of the contract price of the work ¹⁴ completed. Partial payment allowed under this subsection is not acceptance ¹⁵ or approval of some of the work or a waiver of defects in the work.

"(2) The owner, contractor or subcontractor shall pay interest at the rate of one percent per month on the final payment due the contractor or subcontractor. [*Except as provided in ORS 701.430 (2)*,] The interest shall commence 30 days after the contractor or subcontractor has completed and the owner has accepted the work under the contract for construction for which the final payment is due. The interest shall run until the date when final payment is tendered to the contractor or subcontractor. When the contrac-

tor or subcontractor considers the work that the contractor or subcontractor 1 is contracted to perform to be complete, the contractor or subcontractor $\mathbf{2}$ shall notify the party to whom the contractor or subcontractor is responsible 3 for performing the construction work under the contract. The party shall, 4 within 15 days after receiving the notice, either accept the work or notify $\mathbf{5}$ the contractor or subcontractor of work yet to be performed under the con-6 tract. If the party does not accept the work or does not notify the contractor 7 or subcontractor of work yet to be performed within the time allowed, the 8 interest required under this subsection shall commence 30 days after the end 9 of the 15-day period. 10

"(3) When a contractor pays a subcontractor in full, including the amount 11 the contractor withheld as retainage, the owner with whom the contractor 12has the contract shall pay the contractor, out of the amount that the owner 13 withheld from the contractor as retainage, a sum equal to the amount of 14 retainage that the contractor paid the subcontractor. The contractor shall 15notify the owner when the contractor pays a subcontractor in full under this 16 section and the owner shall, within 15 days after receiving the notice, pay 17 the contractor the amount due the contractor under this subsection. Interest 18 on the amount due the contractor at the rate of one percent per month shall 19 commence 30 days after the owner receives notice of full payment to the 20subcontractor. 21

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"<u>SECTION 3.</u> ORS 701.430 is amended to read:

"701.430. [(1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section,] A con-23tractor or subcontractor may execute and deliver to the owner, contractor 24or subcontractor before the commencement of construction for which the 25contractor or subcontractor will be responsible for performing a good and 26sufficient bond in a sum equal to the contract price for the faithful per-27formance of the contract. The term of the bond [required] obtained under 28this subsection [shall] must extend to include the period during which 29 claims of lien or notices of other encumbrances based on the construction 30

The bond must be approved by the owner, contractor or subcontractor entitled to withhold retainage. A faithful performance bond delivered under this section [shall] must include, but not be limited to, provisions to the effect that:

5 "[(a)] (1) The obligations of the contract [shall] **must** be faithfully per-6 formed;

"[(b)] (2) Payment [shall] must promptly be made to all persons supplying
labor or materials to the contractor or subcontractor for prosecution of the
work provided in the contract;

"[(c)] (3) All contributions due the Industrial Accident Fund and the IState] Unemployment Compensation **Trust** Fund from the contractor or subcontractor in connection with the performance of the contract [shall] **must** [promptly] be made **promptly**; and

"[(d)] (4) All sums required to be deducted and retained from the wages of employees of the contractor or subcontractor pursuant to the Personal Income Tax Act of 1969, [shall] **must** be paid over to the Department of Revenue.

"[(2) When a contractor or subcontractor does not obtain the bond required 18 under subsection (1) of this section, the owner, contractor or subcontractor may 19 withhold that percentage of the contract price of the work completed as 20retainage that is agreed to by the parties to the contract. The owner, contractor 21or subcontractor shall pay interest at the rate of one percent per month on the 22final payment due a contractor or subcontractor who was unable to obtain the 23bond required under subsection (1) of this section. The interest shall commence 2410 days after the date on which claims of lien or notices of other encumbrances 25based on the construction performed under the contract must be properly filed 26under applicable law. For purposes of this subsection, 'final payment due a 27contractor or subcontractor' means the amount withheld as retainage minus the 28total dollar amount of liens and other encumbrances resulting from the failure 29 of the contractor or subcontractor to faithfully perform the obligations of the 30
