## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2636

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, delete lines 18 through 20 and insert:

2 "(5) To aid and advise the council in the performance of the council's 3 duties, the council may recruit nonvoting advisory members and may estab-4 lish advisory and technical committees that the council considers 5 necessary.".

6 In line 29, delete "Chief Education Officer" and insert "council".

7 Delete lines 39 through 45.

8 On page 3, delete lines 1 through 41 and insert:

"Sec. 1. (1) The STEM Investment Council is established. The council
 shall function under the joint direction and control of the [Oregon Education

"(2)(a) The council is established for the purpose of assisting the [*Chief Education Officer in*] Superintendent of Public Instruction, the Commissioner for Community College Services and the Chancellor of the Oregon University System in jointly developing and overseeing a longterm strategy that advances the following educational goals related to science, technology, engineering and mathematics:

"(A) Double the percentage of students in 4th and 8th grades who are proficient or advanced in mathematics and science, as determined using a nationally representative assessment of students' knowledge in mathematics 1 and science; and

2 "(B) Double the number of students who earn a post-secondary degree 3 requiring proficiency in science, technology, engineering or mathematics.

"(b) Achievement of the goals described in paragraph (a) of this subsection shall be determined based on a comparison between the 2014-2015
school year or academic year and the 2024-2025 school year or academic year.
"(3) To advance the educational goals described in subsection (2) of this
section, the council shall administer the STEM Investment Grant Program
established in section 7 of this 2013 Act.

"(4) The council consists of nine members from the private sector who are jointly appointed by the [*Chief Education Officer*] Superintendent of Public Instruction, the Commissioner for Community College Services and the Chancellor of the Oregon University System and serve at the pleasure of the [*Chief Education Officer*] superintendent, commissioner and chancellor.

(5) To aid and advise the council in the performance of the council's 16 duties, the council may recruit nonvoting advisory members and may estab-17 lish advisory and technical committees that the council considers necessary. 18 "(6)(a) The [Chief Education Officer shall] Superintendent of Public 19 Instruction, the Commissioner for Community College Services and 20the Chancellor of the Oregon University System shall jointly appoint 21a council director. The council director shall serve at the pleasure of the 22[Chief Education Officer] superintendent, commissioner and chancellor. 23

"(b) Except as otherwise directed by the [*Chief Education Officer*] Superintendent of Public Instruction, the Commissioner for Community College Services and the Chancellor of the Oregon University System, the activities of the council shall be directed and supervised by the council director.

29 "(7) Members of the council are not entitled to compensation, but in the 30 discretion of the [*Chief Education Officer*] **Superintendent of Public In-** struction, the Commissioner for Community College Services and the Chancellor of the Oregon University System may be reimbursed from funds available to the council for actual and necessary travel and other expenses incurred by them in the performance of their official duties in the manner and amount provided in ORS 292.495.
