PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2065

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "ORS" insert "679.010 and".

2 After line 3, insert:

3 "SECTION 1. ORS 679.010 is amended to read:

"679.010. As used in this chapter and ORS 680.010 to 680.205, unless the
context requires otherwise:

6 "(1) 'Dental assistant' means a person who, under the supervision of a 7 dentist, renders assistance to a dentist, dental hygienist, dental technician 8 or another dental assistant or renders assistance under the supervision of a 9 dental hygienist providing dental hygiene.

"(2)(a) 'Dental hygiene' means that portion of dentistry that includes the rendering of educational, preventive and therapeutic dental services and diagnosis and treatment planning for such services.

"(b) 'Dental hygiene' includes, but is not limited to, scaling, root planing,
 curettage, the application of sealants and fluoride [and], the administration
 or dispensing of silver nitrate solutions, antimicrobial solutions or
 other antimicrobial agents and any related intraoral or extraoral proce dure required in the performance of such services.

"(3) 'Dental hygienist' means a person who, under the supervision of adentist, practices dental hygiene.

"(4) 'Dental technician' means that person who, at the authorization of a dentist, makes, provides, repairs or alters oral prosthetic appliances and other artificial materials and devices which are returned to a dentist and inserted into the human oral cavity or which come in contact with its adja-cent structures and tissues.

"(5) 'Dentist' means a person who may perform any intraoral or extraoral
procedure required in the practice of dentistry.

"(6) 'Dentistry' means the healing art which is concerned with the exam- $\mathbf{5}$ ination, diagnosis, treatment planning, treatment, care and prevention of 6 conditions within the human oral cavity and maxillofacial region and con-7 ditions of adjacent or related tissues and structures. The practice of dentistry 8 includes but is not limited to the cutting, altering, repairing, removing, re-9 placing or repositioning of hard or soft tissues and other acts or procedures 10 as determined by the Oregon Board of Dentistry and included in the curric-11 ula of dental schools accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation 12of the American Dental Association, post-graduate training programs or 13 continuing education courses. 14

"(7) 'Direct supervision' means supervision requiring that a dentist diagnose the condition to be treated, that a dentist authorize the procedure to be performed, and that a dentist remain in the dental treatment room while the procedures are performed.

"(8) 'Expanded practice dental hygienist' means a dental hygienist who performs dental hygiene services in accordance with ORS 680.205 as authorized by an expanded practice dental hygienist permit issued by the board under ORS 680.200.

"(9) 'General supervision' means supervision requiring that a dentist au-23thorize the procedures by standing orders, practice agreements or collab-24oration agreements, but not requiring that a dentist be present when the 2526 authorized procedures are performed. The authorized procedures may also be performed at a place other than the usual place of practice of the dentist. 27"(10) 'Indirect supervision' means supervision requiring that a dentist 28authorize the procedures and that a dentist be on the premises while the 29 procedures are performed.". 30
