

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 2370**

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, delete lines 15 through 29 and insert:

2 “(a) The department shall post on the Oregon transparency website no-  
3 tices of public meetings required to be provided by the state agency under  
4 ORS 192.640. If the state agency maintains a website where minutes or sum-  
5 maries of the public meetings are available, the state agency shall provide  
6 the department with the link to that website for posting on the Oregon  
7 transparency website.

8 “(b) The department shall post on the Oregon transparency website a link  
9 for the website maintained by the Secretary of State for rules adopted by the  
10 state agency. If the state agency maintains a website where the rules of the  
11 agency are posted, or where any information relating to the rules of the  
12 agency is posted, the state agency shall provide the department with the link  
13 to that website for posting on the Oregon transparency website.

14 “(c) The department shall provide links on the Oregon transparency  
15 website for information received by the department regarding contracts and  
16 subcontracts entered into by a state agency or education service district, to  
17 the extent disclosure of that information is allowed by law and the infor-  
18 mation is already available on websites maintained by the state agency or  
19 education service district. To the extent available, the information linked to  
20 under this section must include:”.

21 On page 3, delete lines 4 through 11 and insert:

22 “(7) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall include on

1 the Oregon transparency website a page that provides links to websites es-  
2 tablished by local governments, as defined in ORS 174.116, and by special  
3 government bodies, as defined in ORS 174.117, for the purpose of providing  
4 transparency in the revenues, expenditures and budgets of the public bodies.  
5 The department shall include a link to the website of the public body upon  
6 receiving a request from the public body, and shall consider recommen-  
7 dations from the Transparency Oregon Advisory Commission for the inclu-  
8 sion of other links to local and special government body websites. The  
9 department shall include a prominent link on the home page of the Oregon  
10 transparency website for information posted to the page described in this  
11 subsection.”.

12 On page 4, delete lines 7 through 11 and insert:

13 “(6) In addition to the information described in subsection (3) of this  
14 section, the Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall post on the  
15 Oregon transparency website copies of all reports that the department, the  
16 Department of Revenue or the Oregon Business Development Department  
17 receives from counties and other local governments relating to properties in  
18 enterprise zones that have received tax exemptions under ORS 285C.170,  
19 285C.175 or 285C.409, or that are eligible for tax exemptions under ORS  
20 285C.309, 315.507 or 317.124 by reason of being in an enterprise zone. The  
21 reports shall be submitted to the Oregon Department of Administrative Ser-  
22 vices in a manner and format prescribed by the department.”.
