² "SECTION 22. ORS 249.035 is amended to read:

"249.035. (1) A nominating petition or declaration of candidacy relating
to a candidate for:

⁵ "[(1)] (a) State office, United States Senator or Representative in Con⁶ gress shall be filed with the Secretary of State.

"[(2)] (b) County office [or precinct committeeperson] shall be filed with
the county clerk.

9 "(c) Precinct representative shall be filed:

10 "(A) With the county clerk; or

"(B) Electronically, in the manner provided by subsection (2) of this
 section.

13 "[(3)] (d) City office shall be filed with the chief city elections officer.

"[(4)] (e) Any elected office of a metropolitan service district under ORS chapter 268 shall be filed with the county clerk of the county in which the administrative office of the district is located.

"[(5)] (f) Any other office shall be filed under ORS chapter 255.

"(2)(a) The Secretary of State by rule shall adopt an electronic filing
 system to be used by candidates to file a declaration of candidacy de scribed in ORS 249.031 for the office of precinct representative.

"(b) The electronic filing system shall be provided free of charge
by the secretary and must:

"(A) Accept electronic files that conform to the format prescribed
 by the secretary by rule; or

"(B) Be compatible with any other electronic filing application
provided or approved by the secretary.

5 "(c) The secretary shall make all declarations of candidacy filed 6 electronically under this section immediately available on the Internet 7 to the public free of charge. The secretary shall make the declarations 8 available in a searchable database that is easily accessible by the 9 public.

"(3) The county clerk shall update the electronic filing system established in subsection (2) of this section to include declarations of candidacy for precinct representatives that were filed with the county clerk in the following manner:

"(a) Declarations of candidacy filed with the county clerk after the
earliest day permitted in ORS 249.037 and before the 21st day before the
deadline for filing a declaration of candidacy as set forth in ORS
249.037 shall be posted on the electronic filing system on a weekly basis.

"(b) Declarations of candidacy filed with the county clerk between
the 21st day before the filing deadline and the filing deadline set forth
in ORS 249.037 shall be posted on the electronic filing system on a daily
basis.".
