"(a) Expend [at least 90] no more than 67.5 percent of all amounts received from the State School Fund and [at least 90] no more than 67.5 percent of all amounts considered to be local revenues of an education service district on services or programs that have been approved by the component school districts of the education service district through the resolution process described in ORS 334.175.

"(b) Distribute at least 22.5 percent of all amounts received from the State School Fund and at least 22.5 percent of all amounts considered to be local revenues of an education service district to the component school districts of the education service district based on the ADMw of the school districts, to be expended for purposes identified by the school districts. "(3) An education service district board shall expend 100 percent of all amounts received from the School Improvement Fund on services or programs that have been approved by the component school districts of the education service district through the resolution process described in ORS 5 334.175.

6 "(4) The expenditure requirements of this section apply only to amounts 7 retained by the education service district after making any distributions re-8 quired under ORS 327.019 (9).

 State School Fund and from local revenue, an education service district
 board shall:

"(a) Expend no more than [67.5] **22.5** percent of all amounts received from the State School Fund and no more than [67.5] **22.5** percent of all amounts considered to be local revenues of an education service district on services or programs that have been approved by the component school districts of the education service district through the resolution process described in ORS 334.175.

"(b) Distribute at least [22.5] **67.5** percent of all amounts received from the State School Fund and at least [22.5] **67.5** percent of all amounts considered to be local revenues of an education service district to the component school districts of the education service district based on the ADMw of the school districts, to be expended for purposes identified by the school districts.

"(3) An education service district board shall expend 100 percent of all amounts received from the School Improvement Fund on services or programs that have been approved by the component school districts of the education service district through the resolution process described in ORS 334.175.

"334.177. (1) As used in this section, 'local revenues of an education service district' has the meaning given that term in ORS 327.019 but does not
include any local revenues distributed under ORS 327.019 (8).

"(2) From the moneys available to an education service district from the State School Fund and from local revenue, an education service district board shall:

"(a) Expend no more than [22.5] 10 percent of all amounts received from the State School Fund and no more than [22.5] 10 percent of all amounts considered to be local revenues of an education service district on services or programs that have been approved by the component school districts of the education service district through the resolution process described in ORS 334.175.

"(b) Distribute at least [67.5] 90 percent of all amounts received from the
State School Fund and at least [67.5] 90 percent of all amounts considered

to be local revenues of an education service district to the component school
districts of the education service district based on the ADMw of the school
districts, to be extended for purposes identified by the school districts.

"(3) An education service district board shall expend 100 percent of all
amounts received from the School Improvement Fund on services or programs that have been approved by the component school districts of the education service district through the resolution process described in ORS
334.175.

9 "(4) The expenditure requirements of this section apply only to amounts 10 retained by the education service district after making any distributions re-11 quired under ORS 327.019 (9).

"SECTION 6. (1) The amendments to ORS 334.177 by section 5 of this
2013 Act become operative July 1, 2015.

"(2) The amendments to ORS 334.177 by section 5 of this 2013 Act
 first apply to expenditures occurring for the 2015-2016 school year.".

17 On page 3, after line 41, insert:

"SECTION 8. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate
 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
 declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect July 1, 2013.".

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
