Public Hearing

HB 3058

Permits Public Employee Retirement System member who is retired to be employed by school district or education service district as teacher of career and technical education without loss of retirement benefits.

HB 3137

Creates unlawful employment practice of requiring employee to create, file or sign documents containing false information related to hours worked or compensation received by employee or retaliating against employee for refusal to do so.

HB 3198

Provides that funds held in trust by mass transit district for purpose of paying post-employment benefits other than pensions are not surplus funds and may be invested in accordance with standard of judgment and care for investment of investment funds set forth in ORS 293.726.

Work Session

HB 2798

Modifies percentage rate and amount of fees that pawnbroker may charge for storage and setup in connection with pledge loans.

HB 2386

Authorizes Commissioner of Bureau of Labor and Industries to issue temporary cease and desist order under certain circumstances.
