Public Hearing

HB 3025

Establishes unlawful employment practice related to misuse of information about criminal charges and convictions of applicant for employment.

HB 3097

Makes inquiring after applicant's conviction history and certain activities related to conducting criminal records check on prospective employee unlawful employment practice.

Work Session

HB 3114

Allows injured worker one year from date health benefit plan rejects claim for benefits to file workers' compensation claim.

HB 3239

Expands definition of "lender" for purposes of Beginning and Expanding Farmer Loan Program to include person selling agricultural land to beginning farmers pursuant to owner-financed agreement or sales contract, institution organized and existing under Farm Credit Act of 1971 and other persons or entities as defined by rule adopted by Oregon Business Development Department.

HB 2893

Permits financial institution to conduct savings promotion raffle, subject to specified conditions.

HB 2960

Creates Oregon Retirement Savings Board in office of State Treasurer.

HB 2005

CARRIED OVER FROM 03/23/2015 AGENDA: Requires all employers to implement paid sick time for employees.
