HB 2375 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes Task Force on Accountability in Public Contracting with nine members appointed by President of Senate, Speaker of House of Representatives, Director of Oregon Department of Administrative Services, Director of Transportation, Attorney General, Secretary of State and Legislative Fiscal Officer.

HB 2617

Provides that contractor may award subcontract only to responsible subcontractor.

HB 2925

Prohibits qualified nonprofit agency for individuals with disabilities from paying less than state minimum wage to employees who are individuals with disabilities if employees perform services at facility or site other than facility or site that qualified nonprofit agency for individuals with disabilities owns or leases.

HB 2987

Removes requirement for contracting agency to hold in account or otherwise reserve moneys for including green energy technology in constructing, reconstructing or performing major renovation on public building if contracting agency determines that including green energy technology is not appropriate.

HB 3031

Requires caller that uses automatic dialing and announcing device in prerecorded or synthesized voice message that device plays to subscriber to accurately and truthfully identify caller and to provide telephone number or other contact information that subscriber may use to notify caller that subscriber does not want to receive calls from caller.

HB 3248

Requires qualified nonprofit agency for individuals with disabilities to pay prevailing rate of wage that Commissioner of Bureau of Labor and Industries determines and to comply with other applicable provisions of state labor standards.

Work Session

HB 2716

Requires contracting agencies to provide as material condition of public contract that contractor remain certified as disadvantaged, minority, women or emerging small business enterprise during entire term of public contract if contracting agency awarded public contract, in whole or in part, on basis of contractor's certification.
