Public Hearing

SB 341 A

Provides that agri-tourism professional is not liable for injury to or death of participant arising out of inherent risks of agri-tourism if agri-tourism professional posts certain notices.

Work Session

SB 358

Modifies time within which state agency that adopts rule must submit copy of adopted rule to Legislative Counsel for review.

SB 515 A

Requires provision of method for users to offer suggestions on form and content of Oregon transparency website.

SB 675 A

Removes requirement that bidder or proposer for public contract with local contracting agency demonstrate responsibility by submitting signed affidavit that attests that bidder or proposer complied with tax laws of this state.

SB 922 A

Exempts from certain regulations legal access provider that charges fee to customer for purpose of providing customer with access to legal consultations and other legal services and that pays administration fee to attorney.
