HB 3291

Allows school district and post-secondary institutions of education to apply for funding to form K-20 partnership. HB 3327 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Department of Education to distribute grants to school districts, community-based organizations and tribes to ensure that students are able to read when students complete third grade.

HB 3497 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue Modifies method by which minimum amount distributed to education service districts is calculated.

HB 2982 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Education for purpose of funding proficiency-based teaching and learning demonstration sites.

HB 3180

Allows Teacher Standards and Practices Commission to use moneys in National Board Certification Fund to assist candidates with expenses related to attaining certification through National Board for Professional Teaching Standards.

HB 3319

Directs Department of Education to evaluate methods to reduce dropout rates.
