Public Hearing

- SB 282 A
Prohibits individual from using title "nurse" unless individual holds nursing degree or certificate and is licensed to practice health care profession in which degree or certificate was earned.
- SB 283
Prohibits individual from using title "Advanced Practice Registered Nurse" or abbreviation "APRN" unless individual is clinical nurse specialist, nurse practitioner or certified registered nurse anesthetist.
- SB 284
Prohibits individual from using title "Certified Nursing Assistant," "nursing assistant" or "nurse aide" or abbreviation "CNA" unless individual is certified by Oregon State Board of Nursing and meets certain other criteria.
- SB 285
Prohibits individual from using title "medication aide" or "Certified Medication Aide" or abbreviation "CMA" unless individual is certified nursing assistant and meets certain other criteria established by Oregon State Board of Nursing.
- SB 521
Permits coach to allow member of school athletic team and nonschool athletic team to participate in athletic event or training at any time after athletic trainer determines that member has not suffered concussion.
- SB 547 A
Creates nurse emeritus license to permit certain retired nurses to engage in volunteer practice of nursing.
- SB 684
Permits Oregon Medical Board to issue limited license to practice medicine to physician licensed in another state or country who holds full-time professor appointment at school of medicine in this state.
- SB 833
Requires Oregon Health Authority to give coordinated care organization at least 30 days' advance notice of proposed amendments to contracts.
- SB 905 A
Adds physician assistant to Oregon Medical Board membership.
