HB 2382

Authorizes court to determine fitness to proceed in probation violation proceedings.

HB 2420

Provides that criminal defendant found unfit to proceed shall be interviewed to determine availability of treatment in community prior to decision on commitment if defendant's most serious charge is Class C felony or misdemeanor.

HB 2901

Modifies definitions of "pen registers" and "trap and trace devices." Authorizes law enforcement agency to install pen register or trap and trace device without warrant or court order in certain circumstances.
