#### Work Session

HB 3086

Requires City of Damascus to distribute to ad valorem property taxpayers all excess moneys remaining in city funds after satisfying all outstanding legal debts and obligations of city.

HB 2961

Directs Legislative Assembly to appropriate amount equal to one percent of total amount of General Fund appropriations and lottery allocations for next biennium to both Oregon Rainy Day Fund and Education Stability Fund if state unemployment rate for previous year is six percent or less at time of last economic and revenue forecast of biennium.

HB 2083

Creates exception to five-year ownership requirement for homestead if claimant for deferral moved to homestead from homestead that met five-year ownership requirement.

### **Public Hearing**

HB 2566 A

Provides that disaster or emergency related work conducted by out-of-state business may not be used as sole basis for determination that business is doing business in state, or that employee has residency or domicile in state.

HB 2239 A

Creates income tax credit for hiring of at-risk or disadvantaged youth or youth with intellectual or developmental disability.
