Public Hearing and Work Session

SB 161

Authorizes county tax collector to transmit electronic notices of warrants for delinquent taxes on business personal property to Secretary of State for filing in Uniform Commercial Code (UCC) system.

SB 864 A

For purposes of natural resource credit against estate tax, modifies definition of "natural resource property" to mean property in state.

Work Session

HB 3199

Modifies authority for issuance of state bonds for benefit of university with governing board.

HB 3034

Provides exemption for property of nonprofit corporation that provides health services occupied or used to provide health services to acutely ill patients or accident victims.

HB 2961

Directs Legislative Assembly to appropriate amount equal to one percent of total amount of General Fund appropriations and lottery allocations for next biennium to both Oregon Rainy Day Fund and Education Stability Fund if state unemployment rate for previous year is six percent or less at time of last economic and revenue forecast of biennium.
