SB 89 A

CARRIED OVER FROM 5/26/15 AGENDA: Authorizes county governing body in each county and Department of Veterans' Affairs to appoint one or more volunteer veterans' guides to provide support services and assistance to veterans, spouses and dependents of veterans, and survivors of veterans, within county or served by department.

SB 93 A

CARRIED OVER FROM 5/26/15 AGENDA: Requires reimbursement for up to 90-day supply of generic prescription drug that is prescribed under certain conditions.

SB 775 A

CARRIED OVER FROM 5/26/15 AGENDA: Provides that evidence of measures taken or vulnerability assessments conducted before natural disaster occurs that were intended to minimize impact of natural disaster is not admissible to prove negligence or culpable conduct in connection with natural disaster.
