Work Session

SB 536

Directs Department of Education to assist public educational entities with developing regional service delivery systems for purpose of providing efficient and effective services for public educational entities.

- SB 730 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Establishes Biomass Heat for Rural Schools Fund.
- SB 898 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Finance and Revenue Directs Department of Education to award grants to school districts for support service programs, education innovation programs and education intervention programs.
- SB 930 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Finance and Revenue Modifies method by which minimum amount distributed for education service districts is calculated.

Public Hearing

SB 493

Removes ability of Governor to disband university governing board or force university to take other action if university fails to make timely compliance with conditions established when State Board of Higher Education endorsed governing board.

SB 860

Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to select University of Oregon or Oregon State University to design and develop career advising and mentorship pilot program.

SB 953

Establishes process by which future interests in specified properties in Klamath County may be extinguished. SB 955

Provides that student whose legal residency is not in school district is considered resident of school district if student attended public charter school located in school district for at least four years and completed highest grade offered by public charter school located in school district.

AGENDA (Cont.) April 14, 2015

SB 957

Prohibits State Board of Education from establishing certain standards for instructional time unless moneys available for state's system of kindergarten through grade 12 public education meet specified percentage of amount of moneys determined to be sufficient by Quality Education Commission.

SJR 18

Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution directing Legislative Assembly to establish education support fund consisting of revenues from sales tax imposed at rate not to exceed ____ percent.
