Possible Work Session

HB 3315 A

CARRIED OVER FROM 6/1/15 AGENDA: Requires State Department of Fish and Wildlife to recoup costs incurred in providing services to executive department agencies for advancing administration of fee-funded programs.

HB 2453 A

CARRIED OVER FROM 6/1/15 AGENDA: Requires organizer to obtain permit from State Forestry Department prior to conducting large commercial event on state forestlands.

HB 3217 A

CARRIED OVER FROM 6/1/15 AGENDA: Requires Department of State Lands to adopt pilot program for providing general authorization for voluntary stream restoration and beaver recovery through construction of artificial beaver dams.

HB 3382

CARRIED OVER FROM 6/1/15 AGENDA: Extends sunset from January 2, 2019, to July 1, 2019, for law imposing general prohibition on growing of canola in Willamette Valley Protected District.

HB 2830 A

CARRIED OVER FROM 6/1/15 AGENDA: Modifies time period for local government to take action on application for permit, limited land use decision or zone change after remand based on final order of Land Use Board of Appeals.

HB 2277 A

CARRIED OVER FROM 6/1/15 AGENDA: Modifies authority of drainage districts to perform flood control activity.

HB 2463 A

CARRIED OVER FROM 6/1/15 AGENDA: Authorizes Department of State Lands to seize abandoned structures and derelict structures on, under or over state-owned submerged and submersible lands.

HB 2509 A

CARRIED OVER FROM 6/1/15 AGENDA: Requires State Department of Agriculture to provide mediation program services when person has reasonable belief that planting, growing or harvesting of agricultural or horticultural commodity on nearby land might interfere or is interfering with farming practices.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2501

Requires that annual report by State Forester to Emergency Board include private property loss information for fires of 1,000 acres or more.
