#### Work Session

HB 2934 A

Requires Oregon Health Authority to convene stakeholder group to provide recommendations to Legislative Assembly concerning basic health program.

#### **Public Hearing and Possible Work Session**

HB 2023 A

Specifies requirements for hospital policies for discharge planning involving patient who is hospitalized for mental health treatment.

HB 2696 A

Specifies requirements for external quality reviews of coordinated care organizations by Oregon Health Authority. HB 2758

Prohibits carrier or third party administrator from disclosing to persons, other than enrollee who receives health services, protected health information relating to services provided to enrollee.

HB 2948 A

Specifies additional conditions under which protected health information may be disclosed by health care provider that do not subject health care provider to civil liability.

HB 3301 A

Requires insurer to permit naturopathic physician to apply to be primary care provider or specialty care provider for purposes of insurer credentials.

HB 3343 Å

Requires insurers that cover prescription contraceptives to cover refills at specified frequency.
