SB 616

Requires State Treasurer to conduct investigation of Community Housing Trust Account, within Developmental Disabilities Community Housing Fund, and to recommend investment strategy to maximize interest and income in account.

SB 617 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes Task Force on Housing for Persons with Intellectual or Developmental Disabilities. SB 659

Requires that minor child be considered resident in determining eligibility for home and community-based care if child lives at least six weeks each year with parent residing in this state.

Work Session

SB 244

Authorizes Housing and Community Services Department to use moneys in Housing Development and Guarantee Account for housing for persons with low or very low income.

SB 503

Requires Department of Human Services to identify applicants for and recipients of assistance under temporary assistance for needy families program who are victims of sexual assault or at risk for being victims of sexual assault.
