SB 48 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits

- Extends sunset for tax credit for employer-provided dependent care assistance.
- SB 659

Requires that minor child be considered resident in determining eligibility for home and community-based care if child lives at least six weeks each year with parent residing in this state. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits

SB 760 \*\*

Increases, for purposes of tax credit allowed for crop donation, percentage of wholesale price allowed as amount of credit.

Modifies size and membership of Alcohol and Drug Policy Commission.

SB 632 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Directs Department of Human Services to establish two pilot programs in rural and urban regions of this state to improve quality and effectiveness of foster care for children and wards placed in legal custody of department for care, placement and supervision. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

SB 700 \*\*

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Health Authority for Senior Farm Direct Nutrition Program and Women, Infants and Children Farm Direct Nutrition Program.

## AGENDA (Cont.) April 14, 2015

#### SB 741

Directs Department of Human Services to adopt administrative rules for home studies and placement reports in adoption proceedings that require that equal consideration be given to relatives and current caretakers as prospective adoptive parents, and that greater consideration be given to relatives and current caretakers as compared to other persons who are not relatives or current caretakers.

SB 840

Authorizes licensed independent practitioner to initiate or approve prehearing detention in hospital or nonhospital facility of person who is subject of civil commitment proceedings.

SB 939

Directs Department of Corrections to enter into contracts with nonprofit entities to create programs to assist children of incarcerated parents.
