Work Session

HB 2564 A

Permits local governments to impose conditions on approved permits that effectively establish sales price for up to 30 percent of residential development or limit purchase to class or group of purchasers in exchange for one or more developer incentives.

Public Hearing and Work Session

HB 3243 A**

Permits funeral establishment to take custody of unclaimed body of indigent person.

HB 3323 A

Authorizes type B area agency that serves population of 650,000 or more persons to investigate suspected abuse and to bring civil action against person who engages in abuse of vulnerable person.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 3494 A

Prohibits declawing or devocalizing of animal unless procedure is performed by licensed veterinarian under certain conditions.
