SB 359

Limits amount of appeal fee that city or county may charge for quasi-judicial review of city or county decisions on land use application.

SB 360

Requires seller of residential real property to disclose, if known, whether property is located within one mile of land included in inventory of significant mineral and aggregate resources pursuant to statewide land use planning goal.

SB 364

Requires court to use current classification of marijuana offenses when determining if person is eligible for order setting aside conviction.

HB 2327

Modifies statutes relating to custodianship of practice of nonperforming attorney.

HB 2328

Clarifies that party that is not natural person must appear in court proceedings by attorney unless otherwise specifically provided by law.
