#### Public Hearing and Work Session

HB 2609

Provides that information or complaint may be verified by complainant's certifying sufficient grounds to believe defendant committed offense.

HB 2660 A

Provides court discretion to order person participating in driving while under influence of intoxicants diversion agreement to install ignition interlock device if person submitted to chemical test of person's breath, blood or urine and test disclosed blood alcohol content below 0.08 percent by weight.

HB 2776 A

Authorizes peace officer to apply for and circuit court to enter ex parte emergency protective order when court finds probable cause that person was victim of domestic disturbance or abuse and protective order is necessary to prevent abuse.

HB 2980 A

Authorizes defendant to request district attorney to approve extension of stay of criminal proceedings for district attorney diversion.

HB 3040 A

Directs Oregon Law Commission to study and make recommendations for changes to law relating to hearsay in criminal actions involving sex trafficking.
