Subject:HB 5045 – 2013-15 AppropriationWork Session Recommendations

The purpose of the bill is to complete legislative actions taken on behalf of the Department of Corrections to address budgetary shortfalls in the 2013-2015 budget and to provide additional resources to the Oregon Department of Forestry.

The bill appropriates \$7.2 million General Fund to the Department of Corrections for the remaining budget shortfall of \$3.8 million plus unexpected healthcare costs of \$4.3 million associated with a significant increase in the use of the newest Hepatitis C medication, the annual charge for hemophilia medication, increased costs for other drugs, and for outside health care provision. Department savings of \$0.9 million offset the total need.

For the Department of Forestry, \$2.3 million General Fund is appropriated for the payment of premium costs for catastrophic fire insurance related to the 2015 fire season and for the payment of the 2013-2015 biennial interest expense related to the line of credit established with the Oregon State Treasury for the Department of Forestry.

## **Legislative Fiscal Office Recommendations**

LFO recommends the following actions to implement the DOC and ODF 2013-15 close-out appropriation adjustments:

Approve the -1 amendment to HB 5045 to adjust General Fund appropriations.

<u>Section 1</u>. Notwithstanding any other law appropriating money, limiting expenditure or otherwise adjusting appropriations or expenditure limitations, and in addition to any action by the Emergency Board, the authorized appropriations and expenditure limitations for the biennium ending June 30, 2015, for the following agencies and programs are changed by the amounts specified:
