Subject:	SB 128A-Engrossed, relating to state police telecommunicators

SB 128A-Eng includes the base pay of certain telecommunicators as a comparable factor to be considered by an arbitrator in establishing pay for telecommunicators employed by the Oregon State Police (OSP). The bill defines "comparable" for the purpose of establishing the base pay for OSP dispatchers as the base pay for dispatchers employed by the five Oregon public safety answering points with the most employees.

The measure, the original staff measure summary, a preliminary Joint Committee on Ways and Means staff measure summary, fiscal impact statement, and measure history are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS).

The fiscal impact of the bill is \$213,936 in the 2015-17 biennium. The –A4 amendment adds an appropriation in this amount to the Oregon State Police's 2015-17 budget.

Move the –A4 amendment to Senate Bill 128.
