#### **Position Reclassification**

The ORC has not reclassed any position during the 2013 -2015 biennium.

#### **New Hires**

The ORC had two new hires and one promotion in 2014, and one new hire and one promotion 2013.

- One Racing Worker position was filled in October 2014 and is one of two positions that are part-time seasonal (.26 FTE). This candidate was hired at step one.
- The Supervisor of Account Wagering Hub (ADW manager) position was filled in November 2014. This position is a full-time regular position (1 FTE) and is Executive Service. The position of ADW Manager is critical to the agency. There were eleven applicants interviewed and the best qualified candidate was offered the position. The experience and education of the candidate that was hired supports justification of the salary rate of step 6. Step 6 was the negotiated salary for this position.
- The Program & Administrative Coordinator position was an agency promotion in June 2014. This position is a full-time regular (1FTE) position and is management service. This position was filled at step one.
- The Executive Director position was filled June 2013. This position is a full-time regular (1FTE) position and is Executive Service. There were five applicants interviewed and the best qualified candidate was offered the position. The experience and education of the candidate that was hired supports justification of the salary rate of step 6. Step 6 was the negotiated salary for this position.
- The Mutuels Auditor position was filled July 2013. This position is a full-time regular (1FTE) position. This position was filled at step 2.

#### Reduction Options and Long Term Vacancies

• The Chief Investigator position that has been vacant since February 2014 to present. The agency is evaluating this position at its current level. It is possible that the agency might need to reduce or re-class this position. This decision will depend on how many race days requested by licensee for the 2015-2016 race meet.
