- Policy + Funding Issues
 - Decreased boat registrations. A slow recovery
 - Marine Law Enforcement. A significant cost driver
 - Fee Increase. Additional revenue to support current operations

Oregon's 10-Year Plan

- Public Safety. On-water safety patrols and boating law enforcement for 600 boatable lakes, 75 major rivers and over 363 miles of coastline
- Healthy Environment. Working to prevent the introduction of aquatic invasive species through education and inspection stations







Oregon State Marine Board Investments



Fee changes to maintain current investments

- **Revenue + Administration.** Increased fees would generate \$5.9 million Other Funds revenue for the 2015-17 biennium. This fee also eliminates two positions for \$239,412 Other Funds savings
- Law Enforcement. Provides an additional \$918,000 Other Funds to support local law enforcement and on-water patrol hours (71,310 hours)
- Facility Investments. Provides an additional \$1,108,587 Other Funds and \$500,000 Federal Funds to increase local facility investment grants
